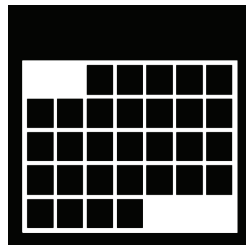

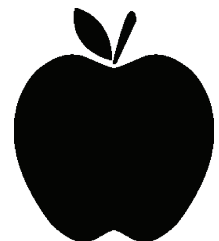

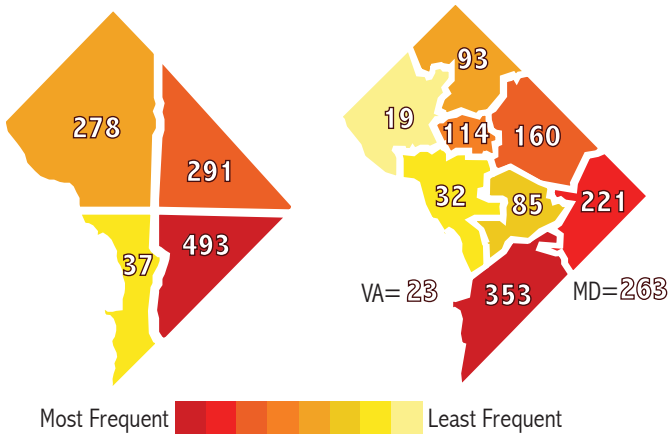

### DEMOGRAPHICS

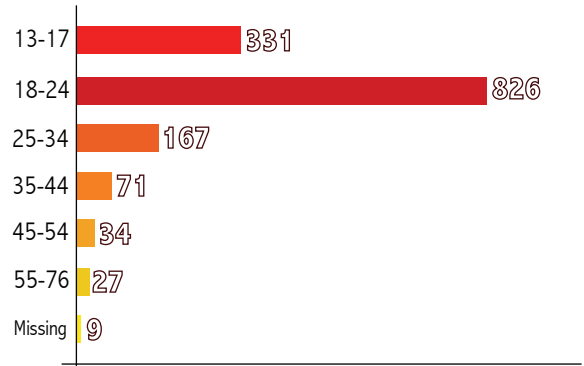
#### Geography

- The majority of HIV test recipients were DC residents (78%), compared to 18% for Maryland and 2% for Virginia
- The majority of DC residents who received an HIV test lived in the SE quadrant
- Most MTA testing clients lived in wards 7 and 8
- 344 testing clients did not disclose their DC Ward



#### Age

Most of MTA's testing clients are between the ages of 18 and 24 years.



#### Gender

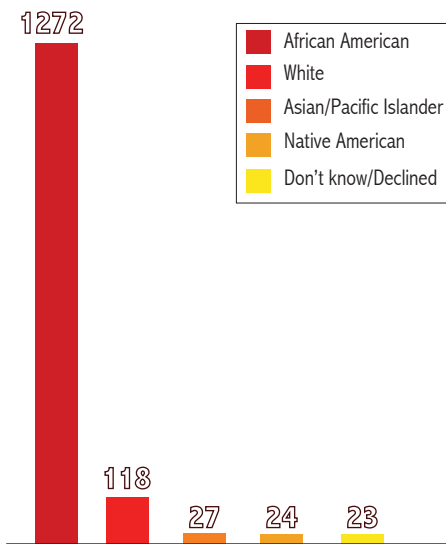
Over 99% of MTA's testing clients self-identify as female or male\*



\*Less than 1% of MTA's clients self-identify as transgender MTF or FTM

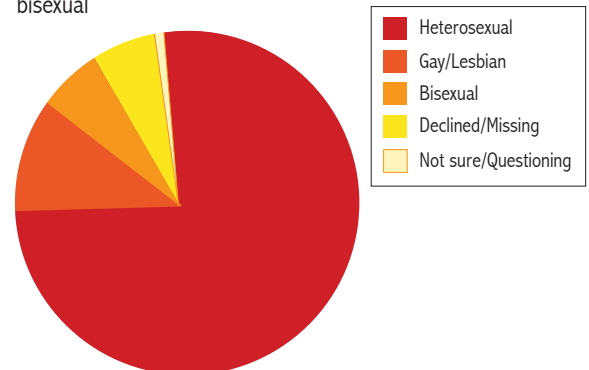
#### Race/Ethnicity

- Most of MTA's testing clients were African American
- Less than 10% of MTA's testing clients identify as Hispanic or Latino



#### Sexual Identity

- The majority of MTA HIV testing clients identify as heterosexual
- About 17% of all MTA HIV testing clients report as gay/lesbian or bisexual

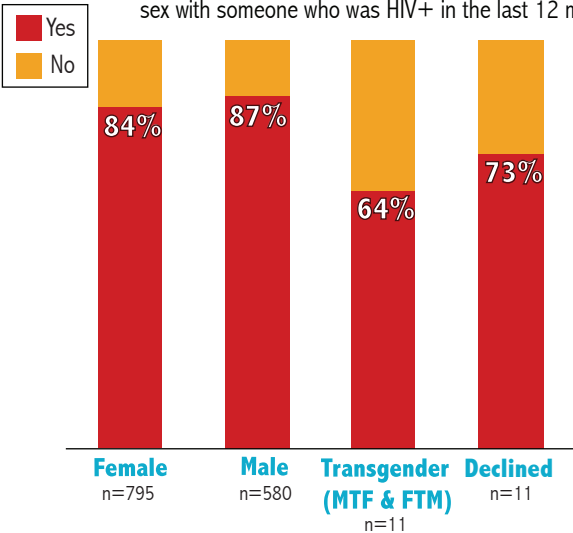

## RISK BEHAVIORS

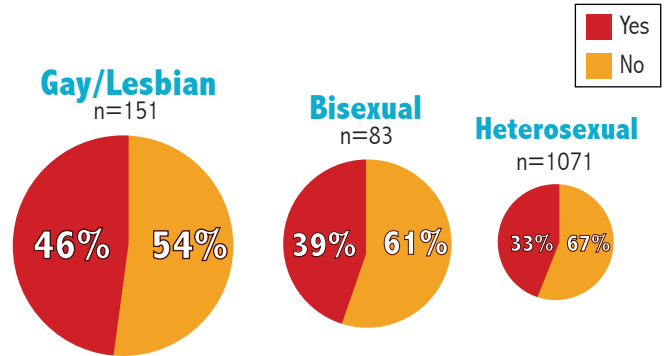
### Sexual Activity

- 87% of males and 84% of females reported engaging in vaginal or anal sex in the past 12 months
- 3.4% of males and less than 1% of females reported having sex with someone who was HIV+ in the last 12 months



### Sex Under the Influence (cont.)

Gay/lesbians (46%) and bisexuals (39%) were more likely than heterosexuals (33%) to report having sex while intoxicated or high in the past 12 months



## HIV TESTING

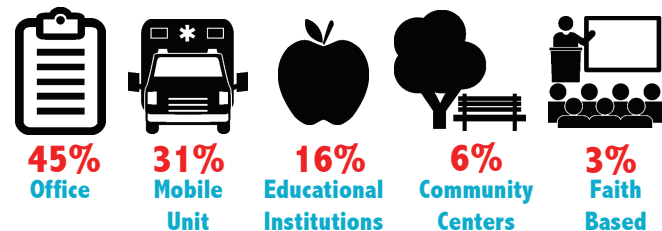
### Test Results

- In 11 months, 1,465 people were tested for HIV at least once
- 1 in 100 clients received an HIV+ test result



### Testing Locations

Most HIV testing takes place in the MTA office



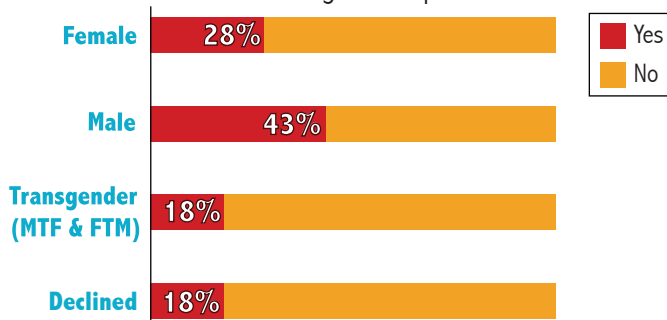
### Sex Without a Condom

- Nearly two-thirds of females and males report having sex without a condom in the past 12 months
- 55% of our transgender (n=11) clients also reported having sex without a condom in the past 12 months



### Sex Under the Influence

Males were more likely than females to report having sex while intoxicated or high in the past 12 months



### Positivity Rate

- The positivity rate by sexual identity was 5% for gay/lesbian, 5% for bisexual and less than 1% for heterosexual clients
- The positivity rate by gender identity was 9% for transgender, 2% for males and less than 1% for female clients

1 in 100 clients received an HIV+ test result

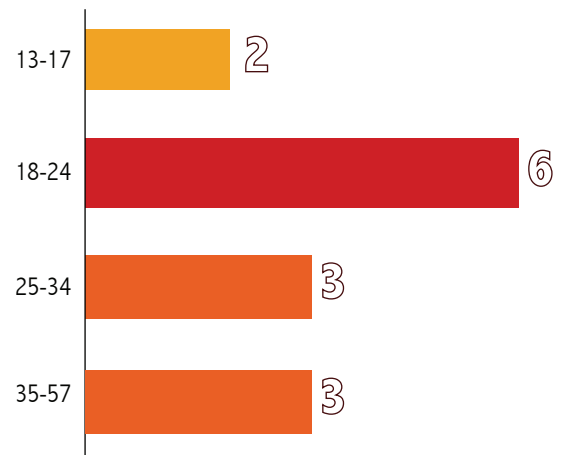
#### Gender

12 males tested HIV+, compared to 1 female and 1 transgender woman



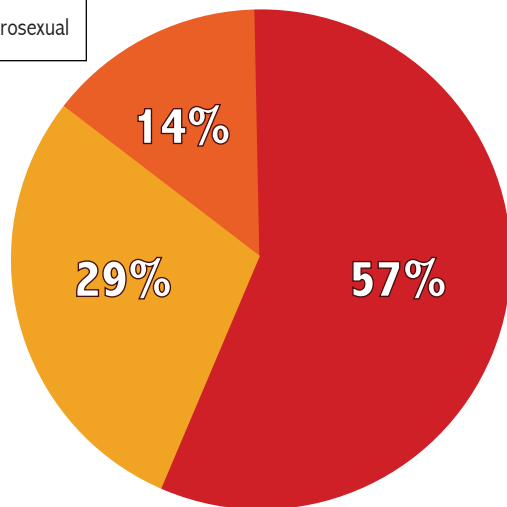
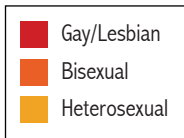
#### Age

The majority of clients who tested HIV+ were between ages 13 and 24 (n=8)



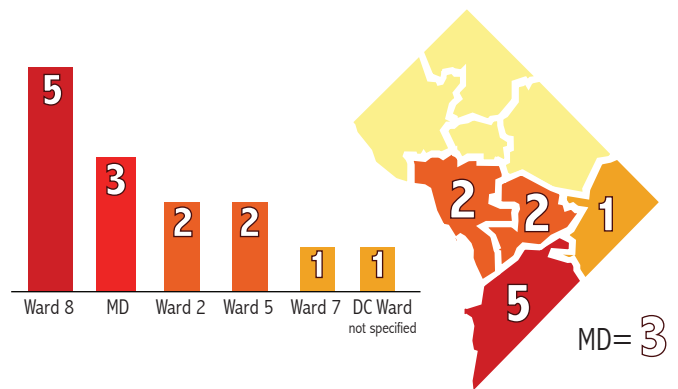
#### Sexual Identity

8 gay men tested HIV+, compared to 4 bisexuals and 2 heterosexuals



#### Location of Residence

- Those who tested HIV+ lived in DC Wards 2, 5, 7, and 8
- 3 individuals had a Maryland residence
- 1 individual did not specify a DC Ward

12 clients tested HIV+ at the MTA office and 2 tested HIV+ at church testing events

#### Race/Ethnicity

- All of our clients who tested HIV+ identified as African American
- One also reported Hispanic/Latino ethnicity
